



- ★ All application materials including transcripts, letters of recommendation, test scores, and other required materials are due no later than December 1, 2014.
- ★ An incomplete application file will negatively impact your audition invitation and final admission decision.
- ★ You should plan to submit your application and start gathering your materials at least two weeks before the deadline (November 15). If you wait until December 1 to begin the application, all of your materials will be late.
