Graduate Application Checklist—Ed.S. & Ph.D. in School Psychology Deadline December 1

Uploading documents with the online application

The Department of Educational Studies requires that you upload all application documents (including transcripts) with your online application. The only exceptions are official test scores (which are sent electronically from the testing center) and electronic letters of recommendation (which are submitted by the recommender after the application is submitted).

Step 1: Prepare documents for your application. This includes your statement of intent, CV/resume, names and email addresses of your letter writers and academic writing samples when required. It is important to have all your documents ready to upload before you begin the online application. Once you click the submit button you cannot go back and upload documents.

Step 2: Be sure you have official copies of your transcripts available for upload. Advising reports or web grade reports will NOT be accepted. Be sure to include a copy of the back of the transcript or transcript key in your upload. Scanned transcripts are considered unofficial but sufficient for the admission process. If admitted, you will be required to submit final, official transcripts sent directly from the issuing institution to our office before you can enroll in your first term of study at The Ohio State University.

□ Apply online* at https://www.applyweb.com/apply/osugrad/index.html. Application fees of \$60 US and \$70 International are non-refundable. *Fee only applies to applicants new to Ohio State.

IF you previously enrolled as a degree seeking graduate student at Ohio State, submit a Request for Transfer of Graduate Program form http://gradsch.osu.edu/Depo/PDF/TransferGradProgram.pdf and a copy of your application file from your previous academic department with the items listed below. If your transcripts and your GRE scores are included in your previous file, you do not need to submit new copies. You DO need to submit transcripts for any coursework completed since leaving your previous program. All other application materials should be sent electronically to EdStudies@osu.edu.

- One original copy of transcripts from each university -level school attended should be uploaded. Do not send transcripts of course work taken at Ohio State.
- Official GRE scores. Send to institution code 1592 only. GRE Scores are required of all Ed.S. and Ph.D. applicants.
- ☐ **Statement of intent**—See page 2 for outline.
- Three letters of recommendation—Letters must be submitted electronically through the process outlined on page 5 of the Graduate Admissions online application and must come from the writer's educational or professional institution email address. Please remember to check "yes" to use online references. Intra-university transfer students (already admitted to Ohio State's Graduate School) should forward the link for the reference form http://admissions.osu.edu/apps/pdfs/refer.pdf to your writers who can then send them via email to us at EdStudies@osu.edu.

Statement of Intent

(1-3 pages)

In lieu of a statement of intent, we request that you answer the following questions. Please limit your responses to no more than three (3) pages.

- Why do you want to become a school psychologist?
- 2. Why are you interested in Ohio State's School Psychology Program?
- 3. Describe your experiences with children.
- 4. Describe your experiences and interest in working with diverse and urban populations.
- 5. Describe your experiences in school settings.
- 6. Describe your research experiences and interests.
- 7. What do you value in a mentor?
- 8. At this time, identify which faculty member you would like as a mentor and why?
- 9. Describe yourself as a student including both strengths and weaknesses.
- 10. How do you respond to stress and novel situations?
- 11. What would you like to do after graduating with a degree in school psychology?
- 12. What additional information do you want us to know about you?

Application Reminders

- 1. The online application for new applicants will open after August 1, 2013.
- 2. Once you have filled out and paid for an application (new applicants only), you can check your application status online at http://appstatus.osu.edu. Please note: It can take up to 48 hours for the system to reflect changes made to your application (i.e., receipt of materials). Remember, you are responsible for monitoring the status of your application. If items are not received by the published deadline, your application will not be reviewed.
- 3. Make sure you give a complete list of the colleges and universities you have attended on your application. If an institution is listed on another transcript and you did not list that institution on your application, you are still required to send transcripts from the places you failed to list. Requesting late transcripts can hinder or halt the processing of your application.
- Please email our office (<u>EdStudies@osu.edu</u>) to let us know if your name has changed (e.g. from name at birth to married name) since the last time you attended a college or university.
- Email is not a secure form of communication. NEVER include your social security number when corresponding via email, including when you are sending in requested materials.
