Personal statement submitted on-line

Scanned unofficial transcript(s) in one PDF or JPEG submitted on-line
Official paper transcript(s) from each college or university attended for credit sent to Office of Admissions  o If grades for study abroad or another institution are reflected on another transcript, separate transcripts do not need to be submitted  o If no credit was received for courses, a transcript does not need to be submitted  o Applicants completing undergraduate and/or graduate degrees from institutions outside of the United States are required to submit a course-by-course evaluation from World Education Services. <a href="http://www.wes.org/">http://www.wes.org/</a>
Graduate Record Examination scores (GRE) submitted by ETS  o only MFA applicants exempt from sending in scores
International English Language Testing System (IELTS) or Test of English as a Foreign Language (TOEFL)  o required of all applicants whose native language is not English except those students who have completed four or more years at an English-speaking undergraduate institution
Portfolio (required of all applicants to any Architecture, Landscape Architecture, Fine Arts or Urban Design degree programs)
Writing Sample (applicants to M.S. in Architecture and Historic Preservation, M.Arch. II, MEBD and Ph.D. programs)
Financial Aid Checklist
US Citizens and Permanent Residents should submit the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) form as soon as possible after <b>January 1, 2015</b> and preferably after their taxes are filed.
Foreign Nationals should submit the internal PennDesign International Financial Aid Application after <b>January 1, 2015</b> .  O Documentation must be provided to verify income and asset information, such bank statements, tax forms, etc.
