

## HOW TO APPLY TO Ph.D. in

## Human Development and Family Science

- Submit online application by DECEMBER 1
  - O Select (Human Development and Family Science Ph.D.).
  - O Select Autumn Term.
- Submit application fee:
  - O Domestic applicants: \$60.00 USD.
  - O International applicants: \$70.00 USD.
- Upload copy of official transcript per each accredited institution ever attended. (In lieu of an Ohio State University transcript, please submit a copy of your Advising Report from <u>BuckeyeLink</u>).

\*Official transcript(s) (exception: The Ohio State University) must be submitted upon admission to:

- Submit official GRE scores to (institution code 1592)
- Minimum GRE score of 152 verbal, 153 quantitative to be considered for college supported graduate associateship.
- Upload the following documents to online application:
  - O Statement of Purpose.
  - Writing Sample
  - O Curriculum Vitae or Resume.
- Submit three letters of recommendation:
  - Choose three individuals who can attest to your scholarship, professional development, leadership potential, or personal character. In the "references" section on page 5 of the online application, please request to have letters submitted electronically by choosing "yes" "use online reference form" for each recommender. Recommenders will receive an e-mail with instructions once you complete and submit the application.
- International Students Only
  - Submit official <u>TOEFL</u> scores if you are an applicant whose native language is not English or you have not earned a bachelor's degree or equivalent in a country where English is the native language.
