# Comparing tuition among the top five iSchools

The following information was obtained directly from university websites by University of Illinois GSLIS staff in November of 2015. Please refer to each school's site when evaluating program costs. Tuition and fee information covers on-campus rates for the 2015-2016 academic year and is subject to change.

#### Illinois:

Degree requirements for MS in Library and Information Science: 40 credits

<u>Cost per ten-credit semester:</u> Resident: \$4,671 Non-resident: \$8,024

Additional fees: \$1,689/semester. \$1,689 x 4 semesters= \$6,756

**Cost of degree: \$25,440 (resident); \$38,852 (non-resident)** Resident: 4 semesters x \$4,671= \$18,684 + \$6,756=\$25,440 Non-resident: 4 semesters x \$8,024= \$32,096 + \$6,756(fees)=\$38,852

# **University of Washington Information School**

Degree requirements for Master of Library and Information Science: 63 credits

Cost per credit: \$745

Additional fees: \$509/quarter. \$509 x 8 quarters = \$4,072

**Cost of degree: \$51,007** 63 credits x \$745 = \$46,935 + \$4,072 (fees)= \$51,007

## School of Information Studies, Syracuse University

Degree requirements for MS in Library and Information Science: 36 credits

Cost per credit: \$1,388

Additional fees: \$175/semester. \$175 x 4 semesters= \$700

**Cost of degree: \$50,668** 36 credits x \$1,388 = \$49,968 + \$700 (fees)= \$50,668

**Cost of degree: \$41,932.76 (resident); \$84,032.76 (non-resident)** Resident: 4 semesters x \$10, 319 = \$41,276 + \$656.76 (fees)= \$41,932.76 Non-Resident: 4 semesters x \$20, 844 = \$83, 376 + \$656.76 (fees) = \$ 84,032.76
