This **2015 Semester two International Postgraduate Research Scholarship (IPRS) Information and Special Application Form** is intended for international students who wish to apply to an IPRS and have commenced a postgraduate research degree at The University of Sydney during the 2014 academic year, or will commence in 2015 Semester one, but were <u>not</u> considered* for an IPRS due to the timing of their application and subsequent enrolment. Students who have commenced their postgraduate research studies at this University prior to 2014 are not eligible to apply.

How to apply for an IPRS?

Use the 2015 Semester two IPRS Special Application Form only if you wish to apply to an IPRS and have <u>commenced</u> a postgraduate research degree at The University of Sydney during the 2014 academic year or will commence in 2015 Semester one but were <u>not</u> considered* for an IPRS due to the timing of your application and subsequent enrolment.

* This will be verified by the Admissions Office.

Where and when should the application be lodged?

Your 2015 Semester two IPRS Special Application Form and any new or updated supporting documents (if applicable – refer to Points 2 and 3 on the form below) must be sent to:

The deadline is 28 February 2015.

When will the result of IPRS applications be available?

Scholarship offers to **successful IPRS applicants** will be sent by the Admissions Office around late April 2015. Only successful applicants will be notified.

If you receive an IPRS offer, the earliest date that your Scholarship can commence will be 1 July 2015.
