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ATTACHMENT TO REFEREE REPORT FORM

INFORMATION FOR ACADEMIC REFEREES

The Bachelor of Psychological Science (Honours) program is an Australian Psychology Accreditation Council accredited fourth year program. Entry into this program requires completion of a three year APAC accredited sequence in psychology which has been achieved at a high level.

The Honours program includes a major independent research project under supervision and a series of seminars covering psychological research methods, psychological theory, evidence-based assessment and practice topics, current topics in psychology, and ethics and professional issues. Assessment includes a research thesis (50%), major essay, and three exams, plus a series of hurdle requirements.
